PAYMENT POLICY

1. The fee schedule and installment options by team are attached. If payment is not received in a timely manner, the player will not be registered with the Rage SC.
2. All dues are prepaid. Reminder notices will be sent 10 days prior to the due date.
3. Joining the Rage Soccer Club organization is a one-year commitment (August 1, 2011 - July 31, 2012). Any player withdrawing from the program at any point during the season requires a one-week advance written notice to the Executive Director and/or the Academy Director.
4. Any player wishing to be released from their respective team within the season may be required to pay a \$50 release fee, which covers all of the administrative costs of their registration and release.
5. Should a player withdraw from the team and club prior to their payment due date, the player's dues will not be assessed.
6. If a player withdraws from the team and club any time after the payment due date, the prior fee will be assessed minus any fundraising dollars they have raised and proportionate financial aid awarded. Until all outstanding balances have been paid, the player's pass will not be released and the player will be placed in "bad standing" with the club.
7. If a player is placed in "bad standing," a notification will be sent to the family and the appropriate soccer association, Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association (EPYSA), USL or US Club Soccer, and any requested transfer or release to another team or club will be withheld until such time as their respective outstanding balance is paid in full.
8. If payments are not made within 15 days of the payment due date, the player may be suspended from all soccer activities until the outstanding balance is paid in full.
9. All player dues are non-refundable. Money will not be returned if the player decides to withdraw during the season. Credit may be given for extenuating health circumstances when approved by the Board of Directors.
10. Rage SC does offer financial aid to those families in need after filing an application and receiving Board of Directors approval. Players who are receiving financial aid and decide to withdraw from the program; their amount of aid will be applied proportionately to the player dues paid and/or outstanding fees.
11. Players who apply for financial aid must pay an initial installment fee equal to 10% of the total fee before being approved for aid.
12. Families with two or more children participating in the program will receive a 10% discount on each subsequent child. The discount will apply to the children with the lower fees. The 10% discount does not apply if players and families have been approved and are receiving financial aid. The discount will be applied to the final installment.
13. Credits will not be given for cancelled practices, games, and/or tournaments.
14. All returned check fees are \$40.
